3 4 5 6 7 8 9	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE RELATING TO REGULATIONS DURING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR A CURFEW AND EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE TERRITORY EMBRACED; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
10	WHEREAS, the County Council of the County of Volusia, Florida, pursuant to Home
11	Rule Power and Florida Statutes, Chapter 252, has declared a state of local emergency
12	pursuant to County ordinance;
13	WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Chapter 252.38, provides authority for a political
14	subdivision such as Volusia County to declare a state of local emergency and to waive the
15	procedures and formalities otherwise required of political subdivisions by law pertaining to
16	taking whatever action is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the
17	community; and
18	WHEREAS, the County Council finds and declares that in order to protect and
19	safeguard the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Volusia County, the imposition of an
20	emergency curfew pursuant to County ordinance is necessary;
21 22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
23 24	SECTION I: A curfew within the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Volusia
25	County shall take effect on Wednesday, October 9, 2024, at 8 p.m. and end on Thursday,
26	October 10, 2024 at 8 a.m. EST (Eastern Standard Time). This curfew shall not apply to
27	regular members of the law enforcement bodies. Regular employees of businesses, industries,
28	or governmental entities, while traveling to and from their jobs, and all emergency workers are

exempt, provided they have identification if stopped by any law enforcement personnel.

1	SECTION II: All territory within the legal boundaries of Volusia County, Florida
2	including all unincorporated and incorporated areas, shall be embraced by the provisions of
3	this Ordinance.
4	SECTION III: Any person who knowingly violates this Ordinance shall, upon
5	conviction, be subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.00, or imprisonment in the County jail for a
6	period of up to sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
7	SECTION IV: This Emergency Ordinance shall take effect immediately unless
8	rescinded prior to that time.
