


**DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY**  
**FOR TROPICAL STORM IDALIA**

Pursuant to section 252.38(3)(a)(5), Florida Statutes, and section 46-143, Code of Ordinances, County of Volusia, the county council hereby declares a State of Local Emergency, effective throughout Volusia County as of noon on August 28, 2023, on this date for a period of seven days due to Tropical Storm Idalia. Idalia is expected to become a hurricane with probabilities of tropical storm force winds, especially gusts, and rainfall exist in Volusia County. In addition to Tropical Storm Idalia, along with Hurricane Franklin in the Atlantic Ocean, the risk of storm effects exists along the eastern coast along with other portions of Volusia County.
