

Value Adjustment Board Public Participation Form

The Volusia County Value Adjustment Board (VAB) allows the opportunity for public comment at all meetings, including meetings at which special magistrate decisions are considered and adopted. Public comment is encouraged on and limited to agenda topics.
Each individual is limited to (3) three minutes of comment per meeting.
Pursuant to s. 286.0105, Florida Statutes, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the VAB with respect to any matter considered at any meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceeding, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, this includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
By VAB Resolution, a written request for participation is required when board action is requested. This request must be received by the VAB clerk at least 10 days before the meeting date. To calculate 10 days, the party shall use calendar days and shall not include the day of the meeting in the calculation, and shall count backwards from the day of the meeting. The last day of the period shall be included unless it is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, in which event the period shall run until the next previous day that is neither a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. Following the 10 days, participation may be requested, although no board action shall be taken.
