



FY 2026/27 CDBG Funding Applications Available

Volusia County's Community Assistance Division receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding annually through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Utilizing the anticipated FY 2026/27 allocation, the division will be accepting applications for eligible capital improvement projects and public service activities. Applications may be submitted by cities participating in the county's entitlement program, non-profit organizations, and Volusia County internal departments/divisions.

The funds include \$1,000,000 for eligible capital improvement projects and \$265,000 for eligible public service activities. Funds must be used to serve clients or groups that are primarily low- or moderate-income. Proposed projects must be eligible under CDBG as described in 24 CFR Part 570. Capital improvement applications must request no less than \$100,000 per application and public service applications must request no less than \$25,000. Applicants are limited to two applications per application type and no more than one per project type. Additional requirements can be found in the Application Instructions and Guidance that will be provided with the applications.

These funds may not be used for projects within the city limits of Daytona Beach, Port Orange and Deltona because these municipalities are eligible to receive their own Community Development Block Grant allocation. Exceptions may apply for countywide projects or projects that meet the area benefit requirements. See the Application Instructions and Guidance for more information.
