



NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

FY 2026/27 Emergency Solutions Grant Funds Available for Non-Profits

Volusia County has U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds available for the implementation of eligible programs. Non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations are eligible to submit applications for this funding.

The amount available for rapid re-housing, homeless prevention, and emergency shelter operating activities is \$139,733. Successful applicants will be required to provide a 100% funding match.

Proposed programs must serve the entire county and comply with the Commission on Homelessness and Housing (CoHH) for Volusia and Flagler Counties written standards which are included in the application. This funding is prohibited from serving Flagler County.
