15	SECTION I. Resolution 2010-20 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17	SECTION 2: A city requesting a delegation of authority or an amendment		
18	of existing delegation of authority to a CRA, shall identify and define how the		
19	CRA will maximize available resources (1) to further the county's overall goals		
20	and strategies; and (2) how the governing body and any planning advisory board		
21	has acted within the prior five years upon any project within the city which had		
22	the potential for an increase of taxable value of \$5,000,000 or more. A future		
23	delegation of powers under the Act shall:		
24	1. limit the contribution by the county to a millage rate		
25	that does not exceed the millage rate used by the city to calculate		
26	its tax increment contribution, regardless of the existing rate		
27	structure;		
28	2. identify the taxing authorities which shall be		
29	contributors;		

1	3.	provide a specific sunset date depending on the CRA
2	plan and bor	nding obligations;
3	4.	limit allowable administrative and non-capital costs;
4	5.	set a ceiling on county contributions or define scaled
5	monetary thi	resholds (e.g., 95% of the tax increment share up to \$1
6	million, 75%	up to \$2 million, and 50% over \$2 million until the
7	sunset date)	;
8	6.	restrict the use of county contribution to the trust fund
9	to a specific	project or projects, or expenditures as defined in the
10	CRA plan;	
11	7.	specify the frequency of CRA plan updates; and
12	8.	determine available incentives for specific goals such
13	as job gener	ation and other economic development achievements.
14	A modified or expan	nded delegation of authority may
15	1.	include any provision set forth above for a new
16	delegation of	f authority as set forth previously;
17	2.	establish different trust fund contributions for the area
18	of an expans	sion;
19	3.	stipulate separate terms and different trust fund
20	contributions	for the period of extension.

- 1 Neither the county nor any city shall give less than 120 days written notice
- 2 for any changes or extensions to an existing CRA.
