EOC Volunteers work alongside emergency management professionals to enhance our community's disaster resilience and response capabilities.

Readiness Roles

- Staff designated positions within the EOC during planned events and exercises
- Help maintain operational readiness of EOC equipment, supplies, and documentation
- Participate in regular training sessions to build EOC operational skills
- Assist with preparing status boards, forms, and communication tools ahead of activations

Recovery Roles

- Staff assigned positions within the EOC during activations
- Assist with information gathering, data entry, situation reporting, and status tracking during activations
- Support communication between the EOC and field operations or partner agencies
- Track resources, requests, and assignments in real time
- Support logistical needs of the EOC during extended operations
- Contribute to after-action reviews and improvement planning processes

- Basic computer skills including familiarity with common office applications
- Clear verbal and written communication abilities
- Capacity to follow established protocols and procedures
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment
