- I/We certify and represent that the Property complies with the Eligibility Requirements of the Program.
- I/We agree to hire a registered/licensed and qualified contractor to perform the septic system upgrade work on the Property.
- I/We understand and agree that the existing septic system on the Property will be upgraded, enhanced, or replaced with a system approved by the State of Florida.
- I/We authorize the contractor to apply for appropriate permits required for the septic system upgrade work on the Property.
- I/We understand and agree that the septic system upgrade work must comply with all applicable Volusia County codes and Health Department requirements.
- I/We agree to allow Volusia County and Health Department personnel access on the Property to review and inspect the septic system upgrade work.
- I/We understand and agree that, following inspection and approval, Volusia County will pay the contractor for the costs of the septic system upgrade work on the Property up to a maximum limit of \$14,000 for Aerobic Treatment Unit (AUT) and \$8,000 for In-Ground Nitrogen-Reducing Biofilter (INRB).
- I/We agree to pay the contractor for any costs or expenses incurred for the septic system upgrade work on the Property which exceeds the \$14,000 for Aerobic Treatment Unit (AUT) and \$8,000 for In-Ground Nitrogen-Reducing Biofilter (INRB) limit.
- I/We understand and agree that the contractor (not Volusia County) will be responsible for any injuries and damages to persons and property caused by or resulting from the septic system upgrade work.
- I/We agree to indemnify, hold harmless, waive, and release Volusia County and Grants Made Simple from all claims, actions, causes of action, demands, suits, liabilities, damages, injuries, losses, expenses, and other casualty to persons or property caused by, resulting from, arising out of, or in connection with the septic system upgrade work and/or the Program.
- I/We understand that Chapter 817, Florida Statutes, provides that willful false statements or misrepresentations is a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable by fines and imprisonment provided under section 775.082 or 775.083, Florida Statutes.
- I/We understand that any willful misstatement of information will be grounds for disqualification from the Program.
- I/We certify and represent, by signing this Application Form, that the information provided for the Program is true, correct, and complete.
